Do you have?

- Abnormal bleeding: during or after sexual intercourse, or between periods
- Post menopausal bleeding
- Unusual and/or unpleasant vaginal discharge
- Discomfort or pain during sex
- Lower back pain.

There are usually no symptoms with early stage cervical cancer but if you are experiencing any of the above, you should speak to your GP as soon as possible.
