Statistics

On 28 April across the world, millions of workers, unions and families stand together. We remember all those killed at and by work and we fight for the living because no-one should ever die just for going to work: Stop it employers/government, you're killing us!

Around 51,500 deaths, over 620,000 injuries and millions made ill by work in GB every year.

Almost all work deaths are due to employers' mismanagement., and inequality and discrimination at work mean that the most vulnerable workers—the poorest, women, young ethnic minority, migrant, LBGT workers— are at more risk of being made ill, injured or killed due to work

Employers must stop unsafe & unfair work, combat inequality & discrimination. All workers must have good health and safety, whoever they are, whatever they do and wherever they work. #Unsafe and unfair work make us sick and may kill us; #An injury to one is an injury to all #Good health and safety makes decent work for all workers everywhere; #iwmd17
